Immunizations Update

Dear St. Charles Parents,

All **Kindergarten (5) and 6th grade students** upon the first day of school in fall 2008 will be required to have 2 doses of the varicella vaccine (evidenced in writing) or proof of having had the chicken pox (written evidence).

In addition, **all students entering 6th grade in fall 2008** will be required to show evidence of a Tdap within the last year or tetanus shot within the last 5 years.

Please check your records and talk with your doctor to determine when your child's last tetanus was and if an additional varicella is needed to meet the state requirements for your child who is entering Kindergarten (5) or 6th grade in the fall.

St. Charles School's immunization status is reported to the state three times a year in accordance with the law. To date we have 100% compliance with the law and a healthy school population, your proactive cooperation is and has been greatly appreciated.

Enclosed is a copy of the immunization card we have on file, **please transfer that information to the new state cards, and enter any new immunizations and sign. Return card on the first day of school in September, please.**

The goal to meet the state requirements to have immunizations up to date by the first day of School Fall 2008.
