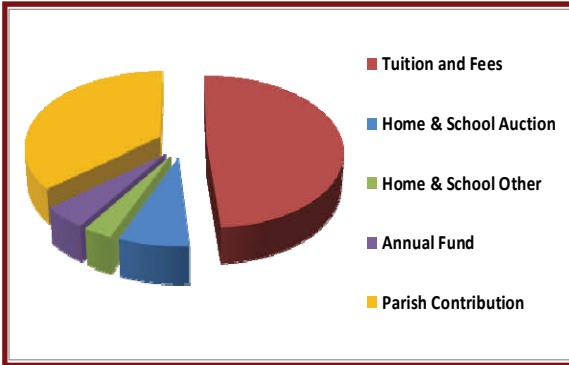


SCHOOL REVENUE ANALYSIS
