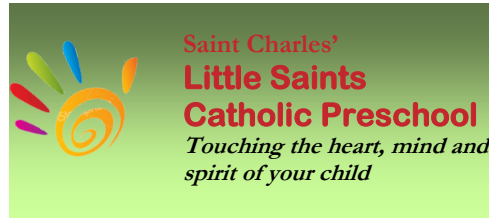
We teach the children to use the scientific method to question and use their imaginations to think about the world around them. Your child is introduced to:

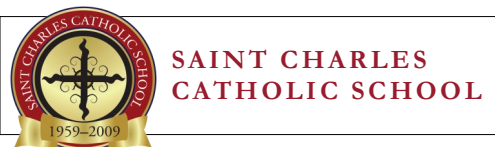

Our Four -Year -Old Kindergarten Program



The Saint Charles Little Saints programs will touch the heart, mind and spirit of your child. We believe that we are responsible for helping each child grow to become

a lifelong learner. While nurturing the spiritual, intellectual, emotional, physical and social development of the student in our care, we are called to foster each child's dignity, uniqueness and self-worth as we center learning on Catholic faith and virtues.

Admission Eligibility

- Children entering the 4-year-old class must be four on or before September 1. (Early admission at principal discretion with birthdates between September 1 and October 1.)
- Students must independently care for basic hygiene needs.

Curriculum Content

The curriculum is responsive to individual differences in ability and interests. Varying levels of ability and learning styles are expected, accepted and used to design appropriate activities.

Personal & Social Growth

Productive, positive social and working relationships with other children provide the foundation for developing a sense of social competence. The child develops in:

- Cooperating
- Keeping items in order
- Talking with another to solve interpersonal problems
- Showing respect
- Demonstrating self-control

Religion

The children learn about God's world and how to care for it. They are taught love and respect for all forms of life. Your child is enriched through:

- Participation in Catholic prayer and worship
- Celebration of life
- Experiences of Christian behaviors

Reading/Language Arts

We teach the children readiness through the areas of listening, speaking, writing and reading.

Your child will develop skills in:

- Expressing self to others
- Following directions
- Writing of upper/lower case letters
- Experimenting with print
- Retelling/story sequence
- Participating in songs and rhymes

Math

Our math units are activity based plans that provide the children with meaningful learning experiences. These provide more movement and verbal interaction. We use manipulatives to create concrete examples. Your child will develop skills in:

- Number recognition
- Concepts of measurement
- Patterning, sorting, graphing
- Estimation
- Shape recognition
