Update: Mr. Halstead

1. Target funds: goes into TAP. Donations through work have to be designated to a specific fund in the school.

3. Butter braids: \$772 profit. 193 sold and donations were taken as well.
4. Lifestyle: \$847 profit and internet orders are still coming in.
