



SCRIP FOR SCHOOL

You won't have to buy anything you weren't already planning on purchasing, simply buy SCRIP and use it as you would cash!

All profits will go directly to St. Charles School to meet our financial commitment to the parish.

Q. What is a SCRIP program?

A. SCRIP is just another word for gift cards/certificates. SCRIP FOR SCHOOL is simply a program where you order gift cards/certificates for restaurants, local groceries and retail stores, and use them as you would cash. Consider ordering SCRIP to pay for your weekly groceries, or dinner out with your family. Check out the order form...you will see many businesses you frequent on a regular basis.

Q. How does St. Charles School make money from the SCRIP program?

A. St. Charles purchases gift cards/SCRIP at a discounted price and sells the SCRIP at full face value. The discount St. Charles receives on SCRIP represents our profit – usually averaging about 5%. Every time you use SCRIP, **you pay the same price** but St. Charles School receives 2% to 15% of the purchase price!

Q. How can I buy SCRIP FOR SCHOOL?

A. EASY! Complete the attached St. Charles School SCRIP order form and return it with your check to the school office. Or, provide us with your email address and we will send you an order form which you can email back to us. Our email address is scripforschool@msn.com.

If you wish to have the SCRIP sent home with your child, complete the enclosed waiver for the school year and we will personally hand it to them for safe delivery to you.

Purchasing SCRIP requires a little preplanning, but this “no cost” fundraiser can produce enough income to replace multiple small fundraisers.
